2010 Season Preview

Plethora of new starters to see significant action this year

With the graduation of five starters and the transfer of another from last season's conference runner-up squad, the Bears will start the season with a significantly different opening day look. However, when the Bears take the field April 30 at home against 2009 conference co-runner-up Homer they will not be as inexperienced as it may appear as many opening day starters and back-ups saw plenty of action last year in varsity, junior varsity, and summer American Legion games.

Anchoring the 2010 defense at catcher will be returning senior starter **Shane Wandersee**. With some help from his pitchers, Wandersee should be able

Baseball State Champions to slow down the opposing team's running game as he picked off eight base runners last season. Fellow returning senior starter Connor Caldwell will be looked upon to provide leadership as he ably defends the hot corner at 3rd base. Junior Mikel Garner will get the starting nod at Ist base and will be backed-up by sophomore Josh Bezona while junior Matt Chavarria will back-up Caldwell at 3rd base. Junior Eddie Arellano will lead the crucial middle infield positions while sophomores Alec Eastman and Dylan Kavanaugh will bring their excellent glove skills to the varsity level in 2010. The 2010 Bears' outfield will feature plenty of speed led by junior center-fielder and 2009 all-conference selection Raphael Matautia. Flanking Matautia in the outfield will be fellow juniors Austin Cowley and Patrick Pickett along with senior Justin O'Donnoghue. As in previous years, the Bears' coaching staff expects defense to be a strength for this year's team.

If the Bears are to make a run at a Southcentral Conference championship and one of the conference's two bids to the state tournament they must get excellent pitching from expected staff ace Matautia (0.00 ERA, 20 K's in 12 2/3rd innings

in 2009). To complement Matautia the Bears should again have a relatively deep staff as Arellano (8 1/3rd innings), Chavarria (7 2/3rd innings), Caldwell (7 innings), and Garner (5 2/3rd innings) all saw varsity action on the bump last season.

For the first time in program history, the Bears have more home (7-Varsity, 4-IV) than away games (6-Varsity, 2-JV) scheduled. After opening up with a home series against Homer (April 30/May I), the Bears take to the road the following two weekends, first to play 2008 state entrant Soldotna, followed by a nonconference game against Houston prior to a series at Palmer. The Bears then return home to host defending 2time conference champion Colony (May 21 & 22) and finish out the regular season at home in rare mid-week action against Wasilla (May 26 & 27). Bears' players and fans will be praying to the weather gods for rainless game days as minimal precipitation often makes Baranof Field unplayable for baseball. If the weather cooperates it should be a great year to locally see some good high school baseball games. If games are rained out you can bet Bears' baseball boosters will be at the

forefront of the drive to construct the all-weather, vertically drained, synthetic surfaces already designed for the Baranof Park fields.
