## **Community Mitigation Plan**

To help prevent the spread of COVID-19 in Kodiak, the Kodiak Emergency Operations Center has developed this community mitigation plan.

Everyone should continue to practice these personal protective measures to help prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- Social distancing\*
- Wear face coverings
- Wash hands frequently

- Minimize social interactions
- Stay home and isolate yourself if you are sick

Depending on the severity of community spread, the Emergency Services Director may implement any of the following mitigation measures:

- Level 0: Personal protective measures
- Level 1: No gatherings larger than 20 people without the ability to social distance
- Level 2: Essential services and critical infrastructure only; limited patron capacity
- Level 3: Limited essential services and critical infrastructure only

As cases, hospitalizations, and deaths increase or decrease, mitigation measures will be adjusted.

## Community Mitigation Summary Table

Risk	Level	Mitigation Measure	Community Conditions
Low	0	Personal protective measures	No to low levels of community spread
Med	1	No gatherings larger than 20 people without the ability to social distance; face coverings highly recommended	Low to medium levels of community spread
High	2	Essential services and critical infrastructure only (Attachment A); limited patron capacity; face coverings required**	Medium to high levels of community spread; hospitals reaching care capacity; on recommendations of local or state public health guidance
Extreme	3	Limited essential services and critical infrastructure only	Uncontrolled community spread; surge in hospitalizations and deaths

<sup>\*</sup> Social distance of at least six feet should be maintained between individuals and groups of non-household members; if singing or projecting of voice, then a minimum of ten feet between each person (Source: State of Alaska Reopen Alaska Responsibly Guidance, Attachment N, Social, Religious, and Other Gatherings ADVISORY DOCUMENT PHASE III-IV dated May 22, 2020).
